CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The EQCA Expert Workshop is a unique platform to discuss the latest developments in QCA and related methods. In this call for abstracts, we invite submissions from experienced QCA researchers on methodological issues related to QCA. Methodological issues may be illustrated with QCA applications, however, the main focus must be on the methodological development of QCA or a related method.

The EW is an in-person event hosted in the Deprez-building of Tilburg University in the heart of the city. QCA experts from a variety of disciplinary backgrounds will participate in the EW.

Submission procedure

Submit your extended abstract (maximum 1,500 words) to <u>EQCA2024@tilburguniversity.edu</u> no later than 1 October 2024. In your abstract, clearly state which particular methodological problem you address.

You will be notified on whether you are invited to present at the EW on or around 15 October 2024. Submission of a full paper is not required. The EW is a discussion forum rather than a conventional paper presentation session. If you wish to share a full (draft) paper, please email it to EQCA2024@tilburguniversity.edu no later than 15 November 2024.

Please make sure that you save your abstract using the following format: EW-title.docx OR EW-title.pdf.

Paper Development Workshop and rest of the programme

All EW participants are invited to attend an introduction to Analytic Induction (Ragin's latest method) by Claude Rubinson and a panel discussion on balancing in-depth case knowledge and reliance on parameters of fit in QCA studies (among others with Peer Fiss and Sofia Pagliarin). These events will take place successively on the morning of 11 December, before the start of the EW.
